

Phew.... I've Registered. Now What Happens?

What's The Board Doing?

Immediately after the last registration date, your Region Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

When Do The Coaches Get Their Teams?

Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters by August 25th.

When Do The Players Get Called?

You should expect a call from your coach during the last week of August. Your coach will give you all the information you will need about practice times and location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time and location. The practice fields are located at the Chisholm Trail Sport Complex. Teams may begin practice after August 31st.

It's After August 31st, And My Child Has Not Been Called. What Do I Do?

Please do not panic if you see teams practicing and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. The very young teams, in particular, do not always begin practice right away. Also some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by September 8th, please call Steve Carothers at (316) 251-5824.

What Else Does My Child Need?

The registration fee includes a jersey, shorts, and socks. You will need to obtain shin guards since they are required at all practices and games. You may also want to obtain cleats and a soccer ball (size depends on age). Football cleats are not allowed.

How Often Are Practices And Games?

Practices are held once or twice a week (field and times to be determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays with the first game on September 14th. All 6U and 8U games will be at the Chisholm Trail Sports Complex (CTSC) in Clearwater. Older divisions will have home games at the CTSC and away games in the Wichita area.

Refund?

Players withdrawing prior to September 15th will be issued a full regional refund (minus the national dues of \$20) as long as their uniforms are still in a good, wearable condition. Unfortunately, the region has no control over the national dues.

Late registration?

Late registration begins on August 25th. Parents registering their child after August 25th will be charged an additional \$15 to cover late registration costs the region incurs.
